The TrueBeam combines sophisticated imaging, beam delivery, and motion management to accurately and precisely target tumors and protect nearby healthy tissue and critical organs. This technology helps to decrease treatment time allowing for a more comfortable patient experience.

OSF Cancer Center patients will have access to radiation treatment, infusion, genetic counseling, pastoral care and clinical trials. Patients will also be connected with a nurse navigator, something Fulton says will be a life line for patients and their families.
