Nearly 370 patients in the Peoria area who live within 30 minutes of OSF HealthCare Saint Francis Medical Center have been able to receive hospital-level care at home. Patients 18 and older who are stable and have a qualifying condition such as COVID & pneumonia among others can be admitted to the digital hospital program after an emergency department or hospital admission.

Under the program, technology kits allowing 24/7 connection are delivered to the patient's home.

"A tablet, which is how we do our video visits, as well as Bluetooth enabled biometric equipment for us to be able to do vital signs remotely. We also bring a backup power source as well as a backup internet source and a personal emergency response system, which functions much like a Life Alert button." (:15)
