

## **OSF Heart of Mary opening pain and spine center**

Clinic will provide increased access to high-demand care in the Champaign County area

(November 30, 2023 | Urbana, Illinois) — Residents in the Champaign County area will soon have increased access to care for chronic pain and spine issues through a new clinic at OSF HealthCare Heart of Mary Medical Center in Urbana.

The renovated space on the first floor of the hospital is expected to be open for patient care on December 20. Hours will be Monday through Friday 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Services offered include lidocaine and steroid injections and radio frequency ablation, both of which are designed to decrease pain and provide an alternative to surgery.

Zeeshan Ahmad, MD, a longtime spine and pain management provider in Champaign-Urbana, is returning to the area to serve patients at the new center. He will be joined by neurosurgeons from OSF HealthCare Illinois Neurological Institute and other clinical staff. OSF is also exploring adding other providers to meet the needs of the community. The clinic will also have a dedicated parking lot and entrance to make appointments more convenient.

"With an aging population across the country, care for chronic pain and spine issues is in high demand, and it's no different in Champaign County," said J.T. Barnhart, president of OSF Heart of Mary. "Living with daily pain impacts your quality of life. That's why the ability to get an appointment quickly through this new clinic is important. Our Mission Partners [employees] are excited to meet this community need."

People can also choose to use OSF Heart of Mary for related services like physical therapy and MRIs, making the hospital a one-stop shop for treatment of pain and spine issues. OSF HealthCare accepts most insurances, including Health Alliance.
