"People think 'oh this lesion is nothing,' but you don't know what's underneath that lesion you see," Chavez says. "You can have it there for years and it could already be spread elsewhere."

CHAVEZ SAYS THE AGGRESSIVENESS OF BUFFETT'S M-C-C SHOULD BE CAUSE OF CONCERN FOR PEOPLE... AND A REMINDER TO TAKE GOOD CARE OF YOUR SKIN. SHE ADDS THAT SKIN CANCER DOES NOT DISCRIMINATE BASED OFF AGE OR OVERALL HEALTH – BUT NOTES IT IS HARDER TO BATTLE SKIN CANCER AT AN OLDER AGE. MAKE SURE IF YOU NOTICE ANY CHANGES TO YOUR SKIN – WHETHER IT'S A LESION GROWING OR SOMETHING NEW SHOWING UP... ADDRESS IT WITH YOUR DOCTOR. ALSO – APPLYING SUN BLOCK AND WEARING A HAT WHILE IN THE SUN CAN HELP PROTECT YOUR SKIN.
