Avoiding mat-astrophes

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"They take out the blood accumulation so the blood flow will come back into the ear." (:05)

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"That injury also will take a person out of their meet, but it's usually non-surgical. We just have to immobilize them or keep them from using their arm for six to 12 weeks." (:15)

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"There's a bursa, which is a fluid-filled sac that covers the patella [the kneecap] to give it a cushion for the other tissues to slide over. It gets very angry when [hits to the mat] happen over and over. It becomes inflamed. Extra fluid will build up. It gets pretty painful." (:22)

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"That sounds like a no brainer for adults. But a kid has other things to do besides shower after their meet. Their minds are in a different way." (:20)
